The deadline for abstract submission and participation (listener, presenter, etc.) is **10 May 2021**.

Please kindly follow that files are to be named to match the participant's surname (last name) for both the application and abstract, correspondingly, e.g. Smith_application.doc, Smith_abstract.doc.

Publication

Following LSP 2021 at The National University of Life and Environmental Sciences of Ukraine, all presenters (oral, poster, panel etc.) will be invited to submit written versions of their work for possible inclusion in the International Journal of Philology. Abstracts will be compiled under relevant panel discussion and workshop headings and accessible online as the conference proceedings.

If a sufficient number of accepted submissions for articles publication is reached, a special issue will be designated to comprise LSP 2021 presentations. Alternatively, accepted individual manuscripts will appear in regular issues (publication charges to be agreed with the Journal). Note that all submissions will go through the routine peer review system.

Submission guidelines:

For all submissions, clearly indicate:

- UDC on the left, Times New Roman, font 12.
- On the right, author names, degree, job title and full institutional affiliations of the responsible (presenting) author and collaborating authors, Times New Roman, font 12.
- Abstract title centred, block letters, in bold, Times New Roman, font 14.
- Abstract text single-spaced, Times New Roman, font 12.
- Recommended literature, Times New Roman, font 12.
- Contact e-mail address and phone number for the responsible author.
- Up to three conference themes (*feel free to indicate themes beyond the list we suggested*).

Proposals may include panels, individual oral/poster presentations and work-in-progress.

PANELS

Panels should address a common theme, content or methodological area. Panels will be scheduled for 90 minutes or multiples of 90 minutes.

In addition to individual proposals (no more than 300 words each), please also submit an overview description of no more than 400 words highlighting the panel's content and objectives. Provide information about the panel members and the coordinator, stating full institutional affiliations and e-mail addresses.

INDIVIDUAL ORAL/POSTER PRESENTATIONS

Proposals for individual papers (no more than 400 words) must clearly indicate a preference for oral or poster presentation. Following the peer review process, the organisers will determine whether a proposal is selected for oral or poster presentation. Poster presenters must be physically present (join the online session) to discuss their work during the dedicated sessions. Oral presentations will be allocated 20 minutes (15 minutes for presentation + 5 minutes for discussion).

WORK-IN-PROGRESS

Proposals for work-in-progress should be no more than 250 words targeted at oral presentation. Individual presentations will be allocated 20 minutes (10 minutes for presentation + 10 minutes for discussion). This format is particularly suitable for early career researchers pursuing doctoral and postdoctoral studies and for experienced researchers undertaking/planning pilot projects or interested in reporting preliminary results. Please indicate clearly if your proposal falls into this category.
