

PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF SCIENTIFIC ARTICLES

1. Edition collection 1909_@ukr.net by email or through the OJS (<http://journals.nubip.edu.ua/index.php/sanu/index>) sent electronic documents (see. Annex):
 - Information about authors (Vidomosti_Ivanenko.doc);
 - Scientific article (Paper_Ivanenko.doc);
 - Extended abstract in English Article 3 pages of text (Abstract_Ivanenko.doc);
 - 1 reviews signed by a doctor or a PhD and sealed of the institution where the reviewer works;
2. Upon receipt and review of the editorial board of the article authors will be sent a message by e-mail with the enclosed receipt.
3. The editorial board accepts the final decision about publication, and also reserves the right to further reviewing, editing and rejecting articles.
4. Materials issued with deviation from the following requirements for order submission and execution of scientific articles, the editorial board does not consider.

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS OF SCIENTIFIC ARTICLES

1. The volume of research papers of 6-12 pages of text, paper size - A4, orientation - portrait, margins on all sides - 20 mm, spacing - 1,5, font size - 14, font - Times New Roman, paragraph - 1 cm (for the main text and article).
2. Structure of the article:
 - Line 1 - UDC (left-aligned, font - bold). Determine the UDC code, you can follow this link: <http://teacode.com/online/udc/>
 - Line 2 - title of the article (centered, font - bold, capital letters);
 - Line 3 - the initials and surname of the author (co-authors, font - bold); degree and academic status, place of work (full name of the branch font - bold italic), each co-author of the new line, centered;
 - Line 4 - authors e-mail;
 - Line 5 - summary (font size - 14, italic, line spacing - 1). The volume of the abstract must be at least 150 words;

Abstract should contain the main conclusions and results of the work. Annotation compositionally can be built on the principle IMRAD (Introduction, Methods, Results and Discussion):

- The relevance - relevance of research.
- Purpose - the purpose and objectives of the study.
- Methods - information about when, where, as surveyed; information, methods used; who was included in the group of subjects.
- Results - key findings (specifics), the results of the study.
- Prospects - information on how the result corresponds to the findings of other scientists who study the prospects, further areas of work complexity.

Line 6 - key words (font size - 14, italic, line spacing - 1, the phrase used for articles search in electronic databases), they should be concise and reflect the specific content of the manuscript.

Abstract and key words to be checked to prevent software technical translation software because the manuscript will be available in the Internet network: reference (scientometrical) databases, information portals, online libraries.

Line 7 - the text of the article with the following elements:

The relevance where the importance of research is highlighted, existing problems and ways of solving them in the context of research objectives set; indicated unsolved part of the problem.

Recent research and publications analysis, serving a brief analysis of scientific studies on the subject of the article.

The purpose of research, which indicated the purpose and objectives of scientific research.

Materials and methods presenting the main methods and techniques used in scientific articles.

Results and discussion, presenting the main findings of research presented in scientific articles.

Conclusions and prospects of serving the specific findings of the research and prospects of further development shown in the article.

References are submitted at the end of the article (at least 8 sources) in order of mention or in alphabetical order (font size - 14, line spacing - 1). References issued by the interstate standard GOST 7.1: 2006. References in the text of the article should be given in square brackets [1, p. 56; 7, pp. 45-51].

After that is a list of sources in English (References), which is formed by the international standard APA (used when the location of manuscripts from foreign bases). The standard used in the US as a standard design paper (including bibliography) adopted by the APA (American Psychological Association) and is international.

3. Tabular and graphical material can be book size, and with the appropriate quantity. The table must have a serial number indicated on the left front of the table. Name of the table is served above the table (font size - 14, bold, line spacing - 1.5, placing in width). Text table provides headset Times New Roman (font size - 12, line spacing - 1).

Figure should be a single graphical object and grouped; have a number and a name that indicates the outside object (font size - 14, bold, line spacing - 1, placing in width). Location of the figure should be in the text. Figures should be contrasting black and white or in color. Graphic materials should not be scanned.

Figure should be the only graphical object and grouped; have a number and a name that indicates the outside object (font size - 14, bold, line spacing - 1, accommodation in width). Location of the figure should be in the text. Figures should be contrasting black and white or in color. Graphic materials should not be scanned.

4. Formulas (a standard numbering) performed in Microsoft Equation.

5. His not allowed automatic hyphenation of words and macros usage in scientific articles. Paragraphs mark only the key "Enter", do not use spaces or tabs (press "Tab"). You may not use condensed or thin font.

Line 8-16 - topic initials and surname of the author, abstract and key words are provided in Ukrainian and Russian.

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
