Conference languages: Ukrainian, English, Russian.

The organizing committee plans to publish conference abstracts before the conference and proceedings of the conference in the special issue of the Scientific Bulletin of NULESU (agricultural, biological, engineering science).

The registration fee: for EU and USA citizens 100 €, for CIS countries – 300 UAH, for participants from Ukraine - 150 UAH, which includes the cost of the conference proceedings, excursions and may be on site. Publication of abstracts and articles will be charged as 35 UAH per page. Students may take part without registration fee.

Conference participants may arrange their accommodation in hotels of Kyiv city at their own expense.

Registration form must be filled out, signed and sent **before 1 June 2015** to Stanisalava Kovalska <u>stanislavakovalska@ukr.net</u>.

Requirements for abstracts

<u>Abstracts should include:</u> UDK, title of the publication, name, degree (graduate students and applicants must provide information about the supervisor: name, degree), affiliation, city and country. Abstracts should be submitted on one or two full pages of computer text editor Word (* .doc), font - Times New Roman, font size - 16, line spacing 1.0 without hyphens. Margins: left - 2.5 cm, right - 1,0 cm, top and bottom - 2 cm. Materials for abstracts should be sent **by September 1, 2015** to Stanisalava Kovalska stanislavakovalska@ukr.net.

The scanned copy of the abstract must contain the signatures of all authors. The Committee reserves the right to select abstract. After approval of the abstracts for publication details for payment of publication will be sent - 35 UAH per page.

Requirements for papers

Papers should be prepared on Ukrainian, English or Russian language, from 5 to 12 pages on one side of a standard sheet of paper (210 × 297 mm, A-4), 1,5-spaced, while leaving the field following dimensions: left - 30 mm, right - 10 mm, top and bottom 20 mm. The paper should be signed by the author and submitted to the Scientific Board. Editor - Word (* .doc). Article text font Times New Roman, 14 pt, tables - 12 pt. Article title, author's name, affiliation, conclusions, references are centered. Citations and references in the text to the literature and sources must be accompanied by the figure in brackets, which corresponds to its number in the reference list. References should be in alphabetical order and numbered. It is arranged using DSTU 7.1:2006. Foreign names in the text submitted in the original language.

The structure of the article:

- 1. UDC code.
- 2. Title of article.
- 3. Name of the author, academic degree.
- 4. Place of work.
- 5. Abstract (5-10 lines) and keywords in Ukrainian.
- 6. The main material:
 - problem definition, analysis of recent publications on its solution;
 - objective of research;
 - material and methods of research;
 - research results;
 - conclusions.
- 7. References.

8. Additionally, must be provided title of the article and authors name in English, abstract in Russian 5-10 lines and in English - 30-35 lines and key words in Russian and English.

If the author - postgraduate or doctoral student at the bottom of the first page of text below the line the surname, name of the supervisor and his degree must be indicated. First page indicated below copyright notice (right justified). For example:

<u>Tables</u> - using Microsoft Word or Excel, font - Times New Roman, 12 pt: width not exceeding 14 cm frame has only cap; center, vertical orientation, number of columns 7-8. Each table should have a theme title and number in Arabic numerals. The text in each table must be referenced in parentheses. If the table only one a number not assigned.

<u>Formula</u> - written in the program Equation Editor 3.0 (this is an internal editor equation editor in Microsoft Word); mathematical variable values in the text according to the formula - sloping letters.

<u>Drawings</u> - in Microsoft Word using the "Create a picture" (picture not performs over text). The picture must be located in the center, width - less than 16 cm. <u>Photos</u> must be scanned in a separate file called Photo. In the same text should specify the location for photo.

Charts - MS Excel, as pictures. For each formula, table, drawing to do a text link.

To the article added: two per-reviews and expert conclusion. Articles are accepted up to 12 full pages. The electronic file should be named as last name of author(s) in English (e.g. Ivanov S.doc.). Charts, diagrams, photos and drawings send in format JPG in a separate folder with the text of the article and payment receipt (folder name - last name) and send an e-mail to the secretary of editorial Dr. Ihor Ivaniuk <u>i-i-v@ukr.net</u>. The scanned copy of the paper must be signed by all authors. Materials and articles and the receipt about payment should be sent to 1 September 2015 years. Receipts about payment to be sent before 15 of September. The Committee reserves the right to select articles.
