Conference languages: Ukrainian, English.

The organizing committee plans to publish conference proceedings and a collective monograph before the conference.

Registration fee: for EU and USA citizens 100 €, for CIS countries – 300 UAH, for participants from Ukraine - 200 UAH, which includes cost of the conference proceedings, excursions and may be paid on site. Publication of articles and abstracts will be charged a publication fee as 25 and 35 UAH per page respectively. Students may participate in the conference without a registration fee.

Conference participants should arrange their accommodation in hotels of Kyiv city at their own expense.

Financial support

For participants from Ukraine and near abroad countries there is a possibility for reimbursement of travel and accommodation expenses by means of a sponsorship. Requirements for abstracts

Abstracts should include: UDC code, title of the publication, name, degree (graduate students and applicants shall also provide information about their supervisors: name, degree), affiliation, city and country. Abstracts should be submitted on one or two full pages of computer text composed in Microsoft Word (*.doc), font - Times New Roman, font size - 16, line spacing 1.0 without hyphens. Margins: left - 2.5 cm, right - 1.0 cm, top and bottom - 2 cm. Abstracts should be sent before **February 1, 2018** to Kostyantyn Maevskyi via e-mail: kvmaevsky@gmail.com.

The scanned copy of abstracts shall contain signatures of all the authors. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to select abstracts. After approval of abstracts for publication the authors will be informed on details for publication fee payment (35 UAH per page).

Requirements for papers

Papers must be prepared in Ukrainian or English languages, from 15 to 20 pages on one side of a standard sheet of paper (210 × 297 mm, ISO A4), 1.5-line spaced, with the following margins: left - 30 mm, right - 10 mm, top and bottom 20 mm. The paper should be signed by the lead author and submitted to the Organizing Committee. Text

editor – MS Word (*.doc file format). Article text font – Times New Roman, 14 pt, tables – 12 pt. Article title, authors names, affiliations, conclusions, references are centered. Citations and references in the text shall be accompanied by numbers in square brackets, which corresponds to its number in the reference list. References should be in alphabetical order and numbered, arranged using the DSTU 7.1:2006 standard. Foreign names in the text are provided in the original language.

The structure of the article:

1. UDC code.
2. Title of article.
3. Name an academic degree(s) of the author(s).
4. Affiliation.
5. Abstract (5-10 lines) and keywords in Ukrainian.
6. Article body (main material):
 - problem definition, analysis of recent publications on the topic;
 - objective of research;
 - material and methods of research;
 - research results;
 - conclusions.
7. References.
8. Additionally, the following information shall be provided: title of the article and authors name in English/Ukrainian, abstract in English/Ukrainian – 30-35 lines, and key words in English/Ukrainian.

If the author is a postgraduate or doctoral student, at the bottom of the first page in a footnote a surname, name and degree of the supervisor shall be indicated. On the first page a copyright sign shall be present (right alignment). For example:

Tables - using Microsoft Word or Excel, font - Times New Roman, 12 pt: width not exceeding 14 cm, frame has only cap; center, vertical orientation, number of columns 7-8. Each table should have a title and number in Arabic numerals. The text in each table shall be referenced in parentheses. If there is an only table in the document, a table number shall not be assigned.

Formulas – composed by means of MS Equation Editor 3.0 (a built-in equation editor in Microsoft Word); mathematical variable values in the text according to the formula – in italic letters.

Drawings - in Microsoft Word using the "Create picture" tool (picture shall not be placed over the text). Pictures have to be centered, width - below 16 cm. Photos shall be scanned into a separate file called Photo. In the article a location for the photo shall be specified.

Charts - MS Excel, composed as pictures. For each formula, table, drawing please provide a reference in the text.

The article shall be accompanied by the following documents: two peer-reviews and an expert conclusion. Articles are accepted up to 15 full pages. The electronic file should be named as last name of author(s) in English (e.g. Ivanov.doc.). Charts, diagrams, photos and drawings have to be sent in *.jpg format in a separate folder with the text of the article and payment receipt (folder name - last name of author(s)) and sent by e-mail to the secretary of editorial team Dr. Kostyantyn Maevskyi kvmaevsky@gmail.com. The scanned copy of the paper must be signed by lead author. Materials, articles and the publishing fee payment receipt have to be sent before February 1, 2018. The Committee reserves the right to select articles.
