





A Form of Participation

- 1. Session oral presentation.
- 2. Conference presentation, publication of abstracts.
- 3. Poster publication.
- 4. Publication of abstracts/article.

Languages: Ukrainian, English.

Abstracts will be published as the conference proceeding before the start of the conference. Registration fee is for Ukrainian citizens − 200 UAN, for foreigners − 100 €, which includes cover coffee break and excursion and could be paid on site. Publication of abstracts must be paid separately as 50 UAN per page. Students' participation in the conference is free of charge.

Conference participants will need to arrange, and pay for accommodation themselves.

Structure and content

The abstracts should include: UDC, title, author's, academic degree, (students and PhD students must add information about the scientific advisor: name, scientific degree), organization, city, country. The length of abstracts should be 1 or 2 full A4 pages, including figures, tables, list of references. Abstracts should be typed by Times New Roman font, size for text 16 pt., line spacing – 1.0. Text margins: top 20 mm, bottom 20 mm, left 25 mm, right 10 mm.

Send the abstracts as a Microsoft Word file to the organizing committee's e-mail mari4ka_shevchuk@nubip.edu.ua to Shevchuk Mariia by April 1, 2021.

The scanned copy of the abstract must be signed by all authors. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to select the materials of the reports according to the scientific content and compliance with the design requirements. After consideration by the organizing committee of the conference of the received materials, an email will be sent to the author about acceptance of materials and payment details.
