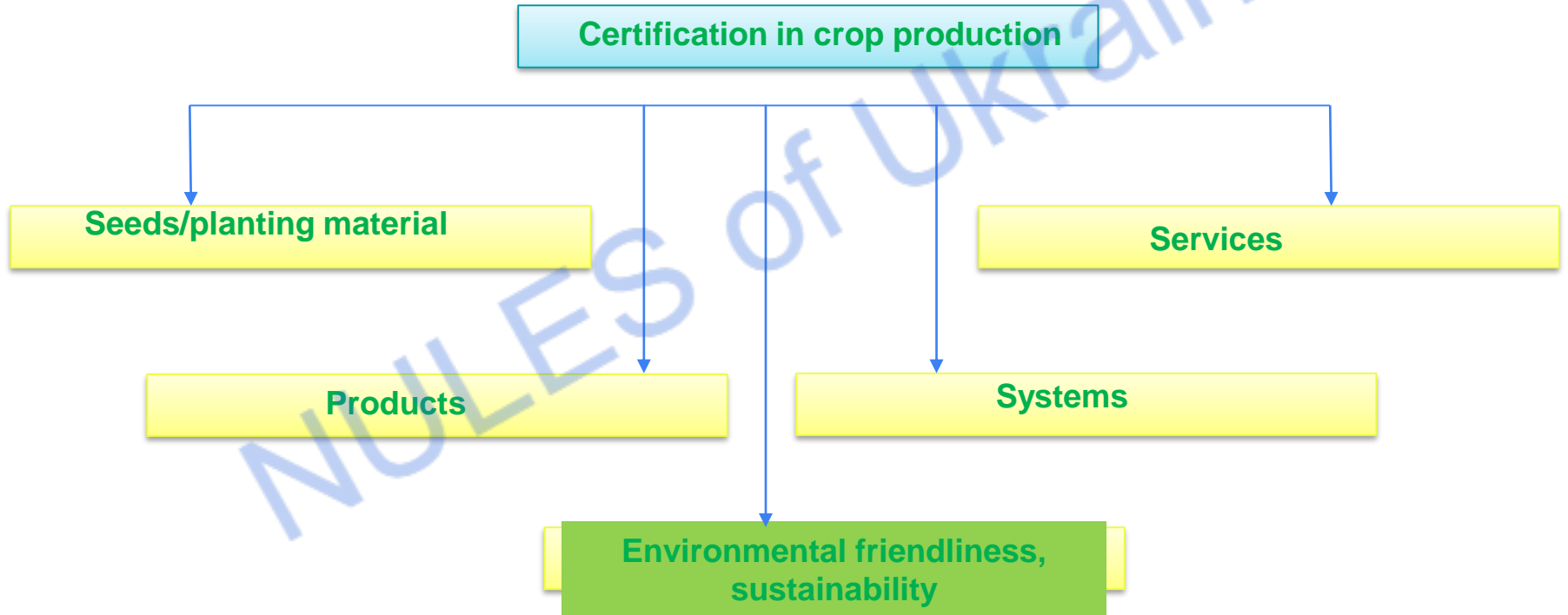

The end of greenwashing: New EU rules for environmental claims

3. In 2026, the European Union will introduce a strict evidence-based system for any environmental claims in marketing. The aim is to stop the uncontrolled use of "green" prefixes and protect consumers from misleading information

1. The end of self-declarations



Mandatory independent verification

Any environmental claims must be confirmed in advance by an accredited body.



2. Only scientific approach Full Life Cycle Assessment (LCA)

Evidence should cover the entire product journey: from raw materials to disposal.

3. Prohibition of general terms



No "eco-friendly" without evidence

General concepts are prohibited without specific, measurable indicators and certification.

Requirements for Crop Production

General requirements for organic crop production are:

- Use of predominantly renewable and own resources;
- Use of technologies that do not harm human health, plants, or animal welfare, and that prevent or minimize pollution of the natural environment;
- Application of predominantly agrotechnical, biological, mechanical, and physical methods for plant protection, taking into account appropriate crop rotations, as well as by selecting appropriate species and varieties that are resistant to pests and diseases;
- Use of methods during the cultivation and processing of plants that optimize the biological activity of soils, ensure a balanced supply of nutrients to plants, including the use of live microorganisms;
- Use of soil-protective technologies for plant cultivation that prevent the occurrence of erosive or other degradation processes in the soil;
- Use of organic seeds and planting material for sowing;
- Completion of a transition period, the duration of which for land plots used for growing annual crops cannot be less than **24 months** before the start of sowing, and for perennial crops (except forage crops) cannot be less than **36 months** before the first harvest of organic products.

In the process of organic production, the use of the following is prohibited:

- GMOs and products produced from or with the help of GMOs;
- Synthetic substances, including agrochemicals, pesticides, growth regulators, and hydroponic production methods;
- Parallel production (organic and non-organic production of the same product by the same operator).

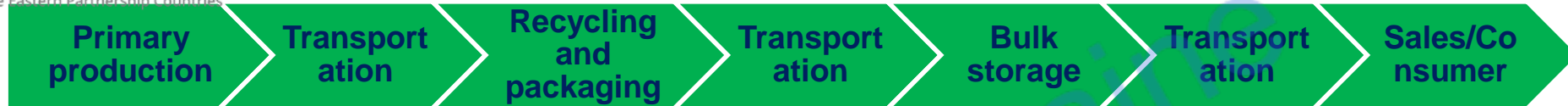
