## Abstract Formatting Requirements

The abstract should not exceed 3 pages, formatted using Microsoft Word for Windows in \*.doc, \*.docx, or \*.rtf file formats. The page orientation should be portrait (A4), with margins set to 25 mm on the left and 20 mm on the other sides. The font size should be 14, and the line spacing should be 1.5. Do not number the pages. The text should not include word breaks or macros.

On the right side of the first page, include the following information about the author: full name, academic degree, academic title, and the full name of the author's (authors') affiliation.

The title of the abstract should be centered, with one line space above it. Use Times New Roman font, size 14, bold, and all capital letters. Do not include a period at the end of the title.
