Participation is **free of charge**.

Requirements for Extended Abstracts:

- Extended abstracts should be submitted in Ukrainian or English.
- The length of the paper is 3 full A4 pages, including the reference list. The recommended number of references is up to four.

Formatting requirements:

- The manuscript should be prepared in Microsoft Word.
- Font: Times New Roman, 14 pt (tables: Times New Roman, 12 pt).
- Line spacing: 1.5 (single spacing for tables).
- Margins: 2 cm on all sides.
- First-line paragraph indent: 1.25 cm (no indent in tables).
- Text alignment: Justified.

The manuscript should be arranged in the following order:

1. Author's surname and initials (left-aligned, bold);
2. Academic degree, academic title, and position;
3. Affiliation (institution of employment or study) (left-aligned);
4. ORCID ID (left-aligned);
5. Title of the paper (centered, uppercase, bold);
6. Main text of the extended abstract (justified);
7. References (arranged in alphabetical order).
