## MEMORANDUM of UNDERSTANDING

between

**JAN DLUGOSZ UNIVERSITY IN CZESTOCHOWA**

and

**NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF LIFE AND ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES OF UKRAINE**

Jan Długosz University in Częstochowa (hereinafter referred to as JDU), with its seat in ul. Waszyngtona 4/8, 42-217 Częstochowa, NIP: 573-011-67-75, REGON: 000001494, Polska, Poland, represented by its Acting Rector, Vice-Rector for Research, Professor Bogusław Przywora, and National University of Life and Environmental Sciences of Ukraine (hereinafter referred to as NUBiP of Ukraine), with its seat in 15 Heroiv Oborony St., Kyiv, 03041, VAT number: UA004937026501, EDRPOU: E10207577, Ukraine, represented by its Rector Prof. Vadym Tkachuk, hereinafter both universities referred to as "the Parties", establish a formal understanding on cooperation and mutual relations which is intended to advance the academic objectives of both institutions and to promote deeper mutual understanding between the Parties.

### 1. Areas of cooperation

1. This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) expresses the Parties' intent to enter into the following activities:
  - 1.1. Exchange of students and doctoral students
  - 1.2. Exchange of faculty members and non-academic staff
  - 1.3. Exchange of information and experience regarding educational exchange programmes and promotion of joint activities
  - 1.4. Exploring opportunities for double diploma programmes
  - 1.5. Organisation of joint training, summer schools, language courses, conferences, seminars etc.
  - 1.6. Joint research activities
  - 1.7. Promotion of the cultural values of the two Parties



## 2. Activities

2.1. It is expected that activities conducted pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding shall be primarily initiated by academic units of each university, and in coordination with their respective administrative units responsible for international activities. All activities undertaken must conform to the policies and procedures in place at each institution.

2.2. The Parties shall recommend students and doctoral students to participate in studies or internships as part of an international exchange in accordance with the provisions of the applicable law of the Republic of Poland and the country of origin of the respective University within the framework of available scholarship programmes.

2.3. The Parties shall undertake measures to promote exchanges between academic teachers and non-academic staff in the field of teaching and training, and participation in other forms of professional development, such as workshops, seminars and conferences.

2.4. Visits to the partner university must be agreed at least two weeks in advance.

2.5. The Parties shall provide support to exchange participants in the visa application process and during their adaptation at the host institution.

2.6. The Parties shall conduct joint research within the framework of available scientific programmes and grants, organise joint scientific conferences and seminars, develop joint scientific and methodological articles and monographs, and carry out other activities for the development of both Parties. The Parties shall disseminate information about research opportunities within their respective institution.

2.7. Should the collaborative research activities under the MoU result in any potential intellectual property; both Parties shall seek an equitable and fair understanding in writing as to ownership and any other property interests that may arise.

## 3. Financing

3.1. This Memorandum of Understanding does not result in any financial obligations for either Party.

3.2. The detailed rules for activities and cooperation undertaken within the areas of cooperation specified in the MoU, including those relating to creation of possible financial obligations, shall be regulated by the Parties in separate agreements in writing.



#### 4. Final Provisions

4.1. This Memorandum of Understanding is executed in English.

4.2. The Parties agree that this MoU shall be deemed valid if executed with electronic signatures. Each Party agrees to use electronic signatures, provided that such electronic signatures meet international standards or legal requirements applicable within the Parties' jurisdictions.

In situations where electronic signatures cannot be used, the Parties agree to exchange scanned copies of hand-signed documents via email or other secure electronic means.

4.3. The Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in force indefinitely from the date it is signed by legal representatives of both Parties. It may further be amended upon a written consent of both Parties. This MoU may be terminated by either Party upon providing six months' prior written notice.

4.4. Any disputes arising from this Agreement that cannot be resolved by mutual agreement shall be settled by the competent Polish courts.


4.5. In matters not covered by this Agreement, the provisions of international law shall apply.

4.6. The addresses given below shall be considered the official addresses for service of the Parties, and only notifications sent to these addresses shall be deemed valid:
