# **ORGANISATION OF STUDY PROCESS**

- In general courses are full-time, but classes attendance is not mandatory
- No weekly study workload. Workload is measured during the final assessment

#### Assessments

- It is usual for most exams to be oral, which means a series of one-on-one question and answer sessions with the examining professors
- Students can accept or refuse grades whenever they want
- Online booklet of exams: Only positive grades are register in the booklet not passed exams are no registered
