
The European Green Deal



Make the EU climate neutral by 2050



Green DEAL CALL- Area 6: Farm-to-Fork



10 thematic areas (Areas) - budget 1 M EUR!



The Farm to Fork Strategy

For a fair, healthy and environmentally-friendly food system

Targets/objectives:

- Reduction by 50% of the use and risk of chemical pesticides and the use of more hazardous pesticides by 50% by 2030
- Reduction of nutrient losses by at least 50% while ensuring that there is no deterioration in soil fertility.
 This will reduce the use of fertilisers by at least 20% by 2030.
- Reduction by 50% of the sales of antimicrobials for farmed animals and in aquaculture by 2030
- Reaching 25% of agricultural land under organic farming by 2030.



(TRL): 5-8 [LINK] Type of project: IA – Innovation Action

Budget: 72 mln EUR (12 mln /topic).

Consortium: international cooperation

(min. 3 enities from 3 different MS /AC to H2020)

timeline: open call 22 September 2020.

Dealine 26 January 2021.

- Starting from Technology validated in relevant environment (TRL5)
- Upscaling
- Limited research activities
- To test, pilot and showcase placebased, innovative systemic solutions



Topics (Scope) 1/2

- A. "Achieving climate neutral farms by reducing GHG emissions and by increasing farm-based carbon sequestration and storage."
- B. "Achieving climate neutral food businesses by mitigating climate change, reducing energy use and increasing energy efficiency in processing, distribution, conservation and preparation of food."
- C. "Reducing the dependence on hazardous pesticides; reducing the losses of nutrients from fertilisers, towards zero pollution of water, soil and air and ultimately fertiliser use."







Topics (Scope) 2/2

- D. "Reducing the dependence on the use of antimicrobials in animal production and in aquaculture;"
- E. "Reducing food losses and waste at every stage of the food chain including consumption, while also avoiding unsustainable packaging."
- F. "Shifting to sustainable healthy diets, sourced from land, inland water and sea, and accessible to all EU citizens, including the most deprived and vulnerable groups."







Consortium



Collaborative project (min. 3 member states or associated countries)



SMEs are strongly encouraged to participate



Mix and integration academia, industry, policy makers, societal actors

- → Foster collaboration, building bridges and breaking silos between actors of the food chain and between primary sectors
- → Take specific care to engage **young professionals** (e.g., young farmers, young fishers, young researchers, young entrepreneurs, etc.), **SMEs** and **citizens**.





To consider in the projects

- Multi-actor and cross-sectoral approach to co-create, test and demonstrate solutions in practice:
 - primary producers
 - processors
 - retailers
 - consumers
 - public and private institutions (NGO and governmental institutions)
 - citizens
- Most appropriate mix of innovations: novel and digital technologies, new business and supply chain models, new governance models, ecological and social innovations
- Delivering and implementing an action plan for dissemination, communication and engagement, for building awareness, education and skills relevant to the solutions on a European scale, in and beyond the regions where the activities take place






