Dear Iryna,

Congratulations on being accepted as an exchange student at ISA, in the framework of the partnership between NULES (Kyiv) and ISA Lille.

You will be registered as a full-time exchange student at ISA in the first year of the Master of Science and Engineering program. The academic year will start on September, 1<sup>st</sup> and end on June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

We are still very attentive to the evolution of the COVID-19 situation and ISA is strictly following the French government and Ministry of Education's recommendations in order to start the Fall semester in the safest learning conditions possible.

We would like to inform you that as of now, **all classes will be available online for students who cannot study on campus due to health concerns or travel restrictions**. All courses will be offered in a hybrid model, combining distance learning with on-campus classes. Students who manage to arrive in Lille during the course of the semester (before September 1<sup>st</sup> or later) will be able to attend an orientation as well as on-campus classes. They will also have access to campus facilities and equipment and will be in contact with fellow students and with their academic advisor for counseling and tutoring. Of course, ISA has put in place rigorous social distancing measures to ensure the safety of all students, faculty and staff members. This means that students who are in Lille (both French and international students) will continue to follow hybrid-mode classes, depending on the size of groups and classrooms.

We advise you to prepare your arrival whenever the situation permits as far as borders, visas and flights are concerned. The International Office will communicate preferred arrival dates for on-campus orientation as soon as possible. We will then ask you to inform us about your precise travel plans so that we can organize your integration in on-campus classes.

ISA Lille is committed to maintaining a rigorous and high-quality educational program regardless of the context. As always, our students will benefit from our expertise, understanding and support throughout the semester. We will work together to adapt to these new conditions, but something that will not change is our dedication to providing an exceptional educational experience to all our students.
