CERAD, UIAR and DIKU is co-organizing a young scientist seminar on Environmental Radioactivity in Kyiv, Ukraine, June 4th - 6th, 2019. The aim of the seminar is to bring together scientists including MSc and PhD students from the Norway and Ukraine in order to strengthen the collaboration. It is being organized within the framework of the Joint Ukrainian-Norwegian education programme in Environmental Radioactivity funded by DIKU (The Norwegian Agency for International Cooperation and Quality Enhancement in Higher Education).



The seminar will cover the following themes:

- Sources and transport of radionuclides
- Transfer of radionuclides
- Effects of ionizing radiation and multiple stressor studies
- Risk assessment, societal and ethical aspects

Location and time frame

The event will take place in Kiev, Ukraine and include:

- Seminar with presentations by MSc and PhD students as well as young and senior scientists
- Field trip to Chernobyl Exclusion Zone
- Excursion in Kiev city

- able to present and discuss your own results and achievements in radioecology and radiobiology or, if you just started working on your thesis, to present (short presentation) the plans for your MSc or PhD work.
