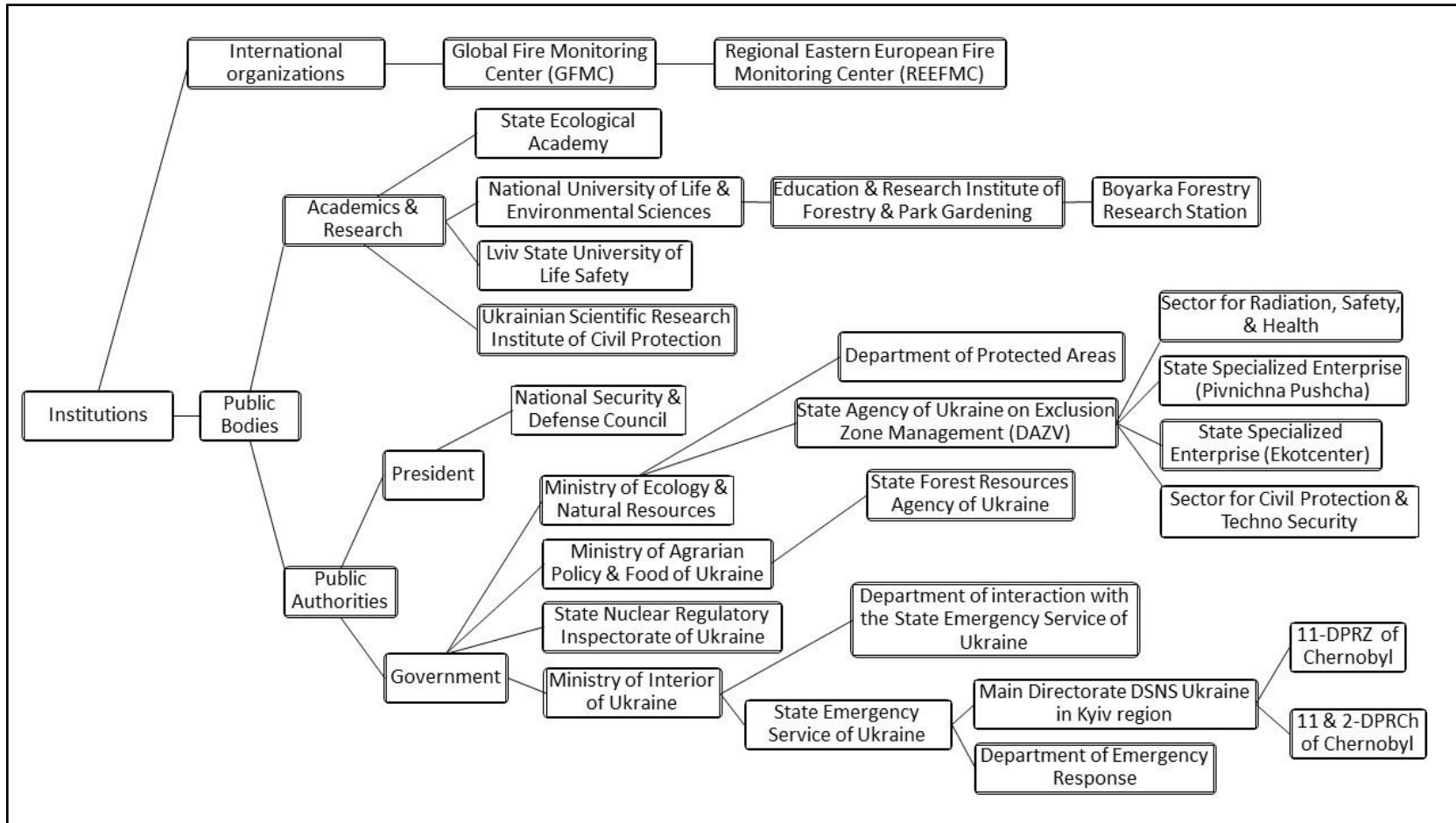

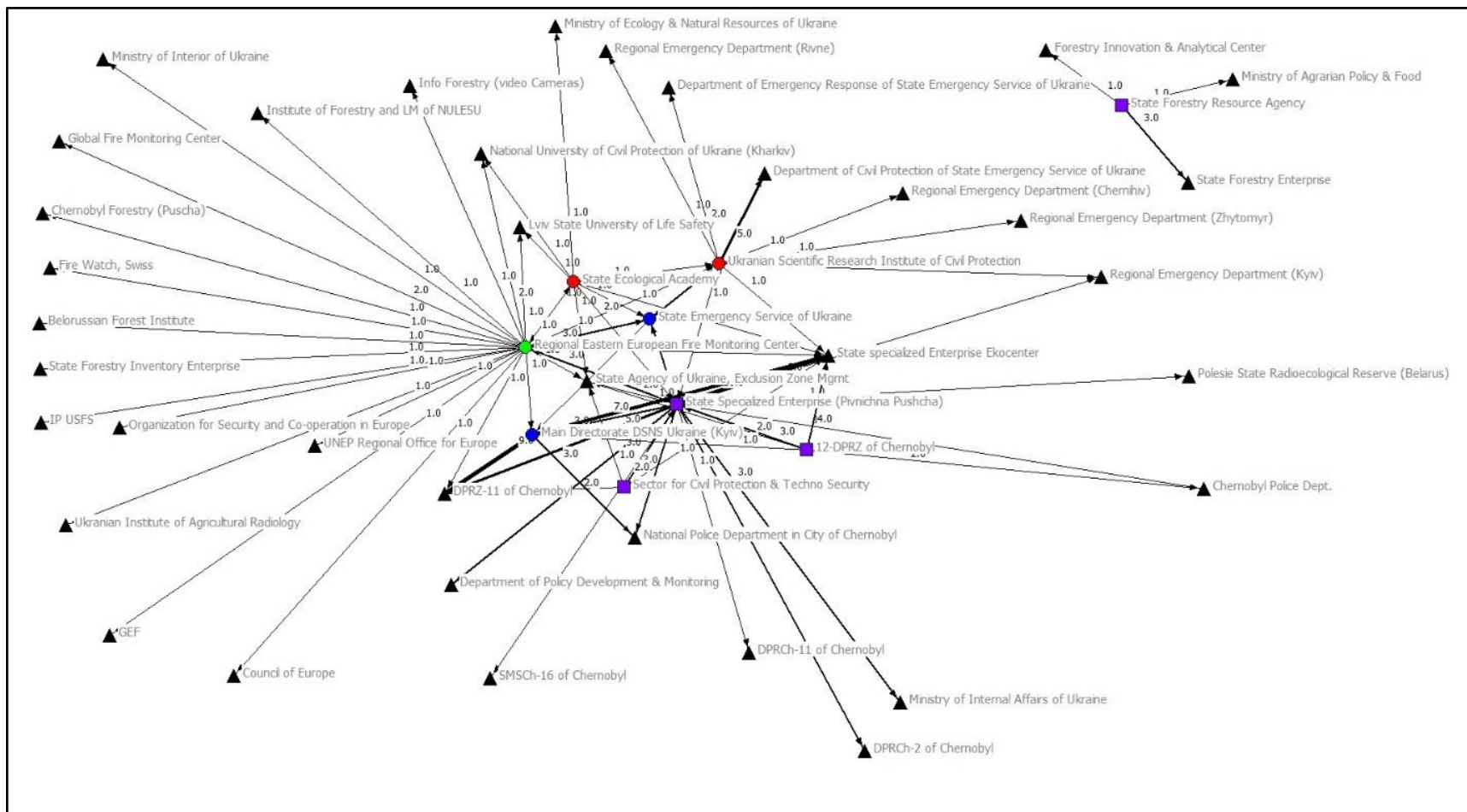

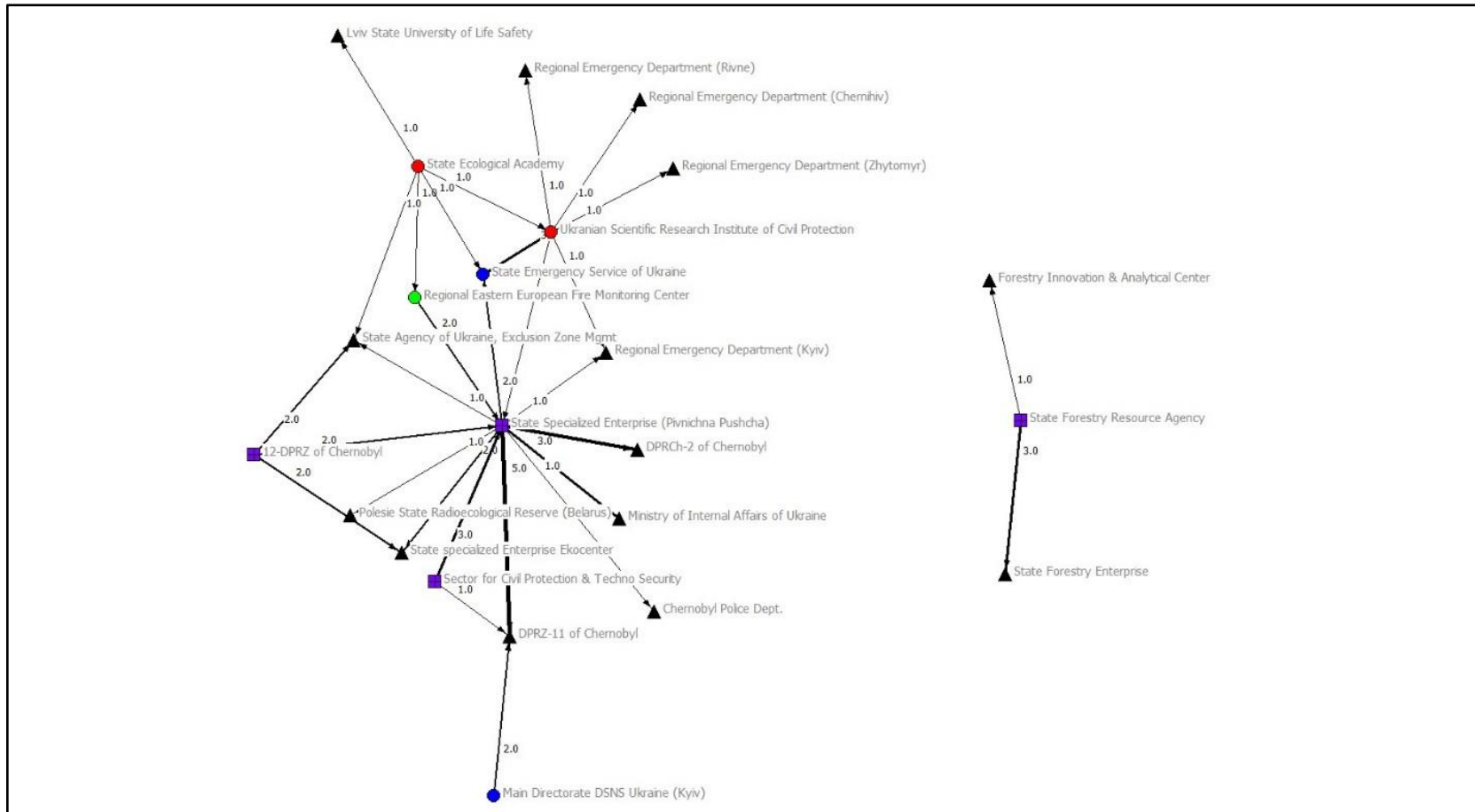

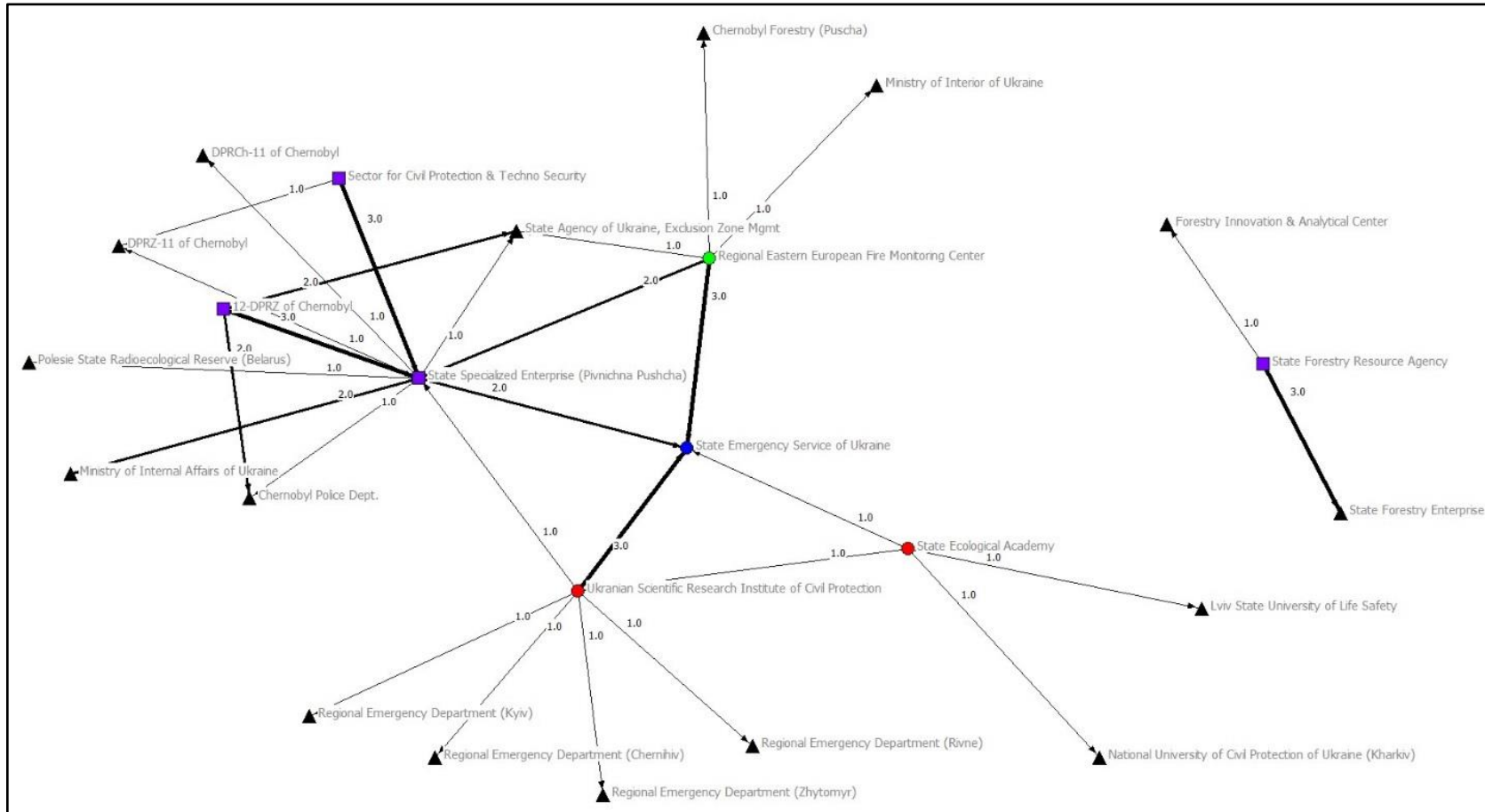

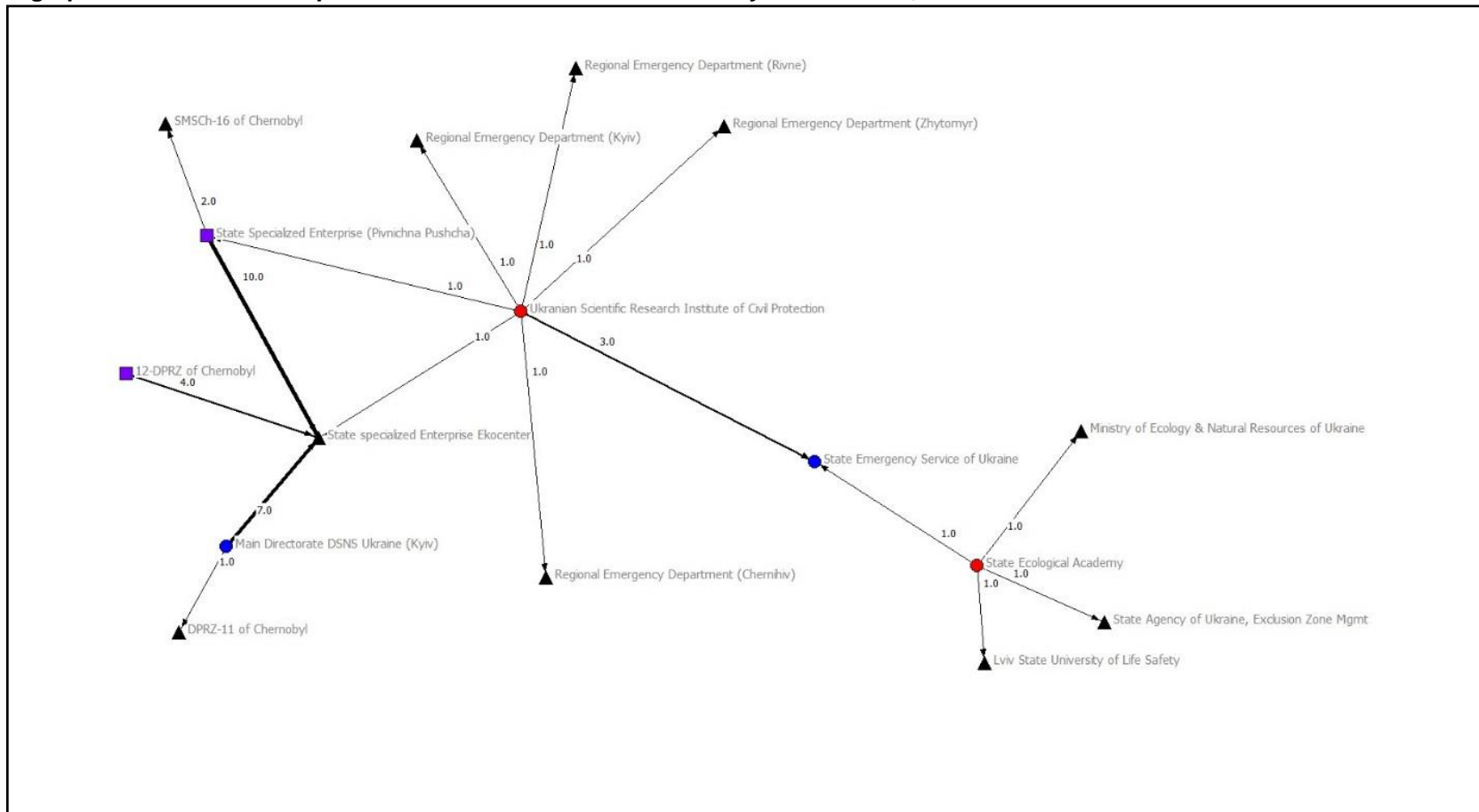
**Digraph of the Pre-Fire Preparation network i identified by interviewees, with waited tie**
