REQUIREMENTS FOR ABSTRACTS

- 1. The participant has the right to send only one report domestic enthat has not been published before (including co-increasing. authorship).
- 2. The maximum number of authors is three persons (including the scientific advisor). For students it is obligatory to indicate the scientific advisor in the theses.
- 3. Volume of abstracts up to 3 pages, which are not numbered.
- 4. Font Times New Roman, size 14, line spacing 1.5, paragraph 1.25 cm, all margins are 20 mm.
- 5. The usage of illustrative materials in abstracts should be minimal.
- 6. The format of tables and figures should be only bookoriented.
- 7. The author and the scientific advisor (for students) are responsible for the content and design.
