

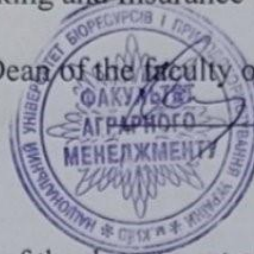

1. Purpose, objectives, competences and programme outcomes of the discipline

The objective of the discipline is definition of the essence and forms of manifestation of monetary and financial relations, mechanisms of their regulation in the state and at the level of economic entities, assimilation of the law of money circulation, understanding of its mechanisms of action, the consequences of establishing a situation

on the financial market and the choice of appropriate financial instruments for effective business development and improvement of socio-economic status in the country.
