DESCRIPTION OF THE COURSE

The educational component "**Crisis management**" is selective.

As a result of studying the educational component, applicants for higher education will master the following competencies:

Integral: Ability to solve complex specialized problems and practical problems in projecting, which involves the use of certain theories and methods of relevant science and is characterized by complexity and uncertainty of conditions;

General competencies (GQ):
