ACADEMIC COURSE DESCRIPTION

The educational component "Crisis management" is optional. The purpose of studying the discipline is to determine the essence, trends, and methods of crisis management; state regulation of crisis situations; study of the possibilities and necessity of anti-crisis management; key factors of anti-crisis management; study of development trends and practical possibilities of anti-crisis management, its functions and directions; features of using basic organizational management tools, study of the influence of various factors on ensuring the effectiveness of the management system. As a result of studying the educational component, higher education applicants will master the competencies.
