Next, information about the author is indicated, namely: surname, initials of the student, name of the educational institution, city, country (Petrenko I.V., student), National University of Life and Environmental Sciences of Ukraine, Kyiv, Ukraine); surname, initials, scientific degree, academic title and position of supervisor, name of institution, country, city (Klimenko V.K., PhD, Associate Professor of the Department of Administrative Management and Foreign Economic Activity, NUBIP of Ukraine, Kyiv, Ukraine).

Text thesis- accordance with the requirements

Formulas must be written in Equation Editor (this editor is an internal formula editor in Microsoft Word)

Drawings should be performed in Microsoft Word using the "Create drawing" function, place them in the center, no more than 14 cm wide without wrapping the text. Each formula, table, figure or graph should be referenced in the text. The use of illustrative materials should be minimal. All pictures are grouped as a single object

List of references: used is required

References are given according to the established requirements, font Times New Roman, size - 12-unit interval

References to used references in square brackets by source number in the list with page indication [1, p.25-26]

Young scientists with a degree can submit theses without a supervisor Abstracts that will be issued in violation of the requirements will not be considered
