COURSE DESCRIPTION

The discipline "International Economic Relations" covers the theoretical foundations construction, operation and regulation of the economic system in the international scale that includes the interaction of business entities, organizations, institutions and governments of countries in different forms and at different levels. Issues of formation and evolution of the international economy. The participation of countries in the system is analysed in detail international division of labour. Special attention is paid to the regulation of international economic relations at the national and global levels. Issues of the main forms of international economic relations are deeply revealed.
