Profile of Keynote Speaker



Panagiotis G. Krimpas is currently Associate Professor of “Terminology, Translation and Legal Texts” at the Department of Languages, Literature and Culture of Black Sea Countries of the Faculty of Classics and Humanities of the Democritus University of Thrace (Greece).

He has also given post-graduate, graduate and summer-school invited lectures at various Universities in Croatia, Cyprus, Estonia, Greece, Romania, Russia, Ukraine, Turkey and Uzbekistan.

Panagiotis G. Krimpas has participated in more than 50 international academic conferences and workshops organised by various academic and research institutions in Austria, Bulgaria, Croatia, Estonia, France, Greece, Italy, Lithuania, Russia, Serbia, Slovakia, Spain, Switzerland, UK, Ukraine, USA and Uzbekistan and has published, in English, Estonian, French, Greek, Italian, Russian, Spanish and Ukrainian, more than 80 works (books, chapters, articles, papers, encyclopaedic dictionary entries, prefaces to scholarly works etc). His research interests include LSP, dialectology, translation (legal, technical, scientific and literary), historical linguistics, etymology, Balkan and Slavic linguistics, geo-linguistics etc. He has participated as a research fellow in or adviser to various internationally and nationally funded research programmes and has supervised, co-supervised or examined many doctoral theses in various universities of Greece.

BORROWED TERMINOLOGY IN MODERN GREEK LEGAL LANGUAGE: PRESCRIPTIVE AND DESCRIPTIVE ASPECTS

Legal terminology is undoubtedly one of the most challenging domains of terminology theory as well as in translation studies. This is mainly because legal terms denote concepts that are culture-bound, i.e. they are closely connected with one or more particular legal systems. Legal terminology can have other peculiarities as well, depending on the language and/or the legal system in question. Modern Greek legal terminology, for example, is peculiar *inter alia* for its 'aversion' to loanwords as well as for its heavy influence of a learned variety of Greek called *katharevousa*, which was the official written language in Greece for many decades. This variety is full of French calques and semantic loans. Law is constantly developing, and native terms to denote new concepts are not always available or easy to coin. Moreover, legal language often incorporates terminology of non-legal fields. Such fields often contain borrowed terms, as is the case with financial terminology, which shows an enormous influence of English. This paper is an attempt to explore facts and possibilities with respect to the use of loanwords in Modern Greek legal language by discussing prescriptive and descriptive stances towards the latter. The conclusion is that, although use of existing non-borrowed terms and Greek-based neology should be the first choices of those involved in lawmaking, legal translation, legal lexicography and/or legal journalism, a small amount of loanwords cannot be avoided. In such instances, adaptability to native phonology and morphology should be the main criterion for accepting a borrowed term or not. Law is a prescriptive field in itself, this is why legal terms produce law. This being the case, some prescriptive processes in legal concept naming could be welcome, despite the descriptive orientation of modern linguistics.
