



## FRAMEWORK COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN MYKOLAS ROMERIS UNIVERSITY AND

## THE NATIONALUNIVERSITY OF LIFE AND ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES OF UKRAINE

Rector of Mykolas Romeris University (Lithuania) and Rector of the National University of Life and Environmental Sciences of Ukraine hereby conclude this Framework Cooperation Agreement (hereafter referred to as 'FCA') in academic cooperation and exchange between the two universities (hereafter referred to as 'the Parties').

- 1. The two Parties will promote in particular the following activities in the subject areas of social science:
  - [1] Mobility of students for study abroad (visiting student) experience, research internships and exchange;
  - [2] Mobility of faculty members for academic visits and exchange;
  - [3] Double degree development;
  - [4] Exchange of scientific materials, publications, and information;
  - [5] Joint research, conferences, applications for funding and meetings for research;
  - [6] Development and promotion of other academic and cultural cooperation as mutually agreed.
- 2. The development and implementation of each activity based upon this FCA shall be negotiated and agreed upon by both Parties in writing, prior to the initiation of the particular activity. All programs and activities under this FCA will be operated in accordance with the laws and regulations of the respective countries.
- 3. All financial arrangements to pursue any of the above activities are to be negotiated for each specific case.
- 4. The details of and arrangements for any publication of research results produced through

collaboration under this FCA must be decided and agreed upon in advance in writing by the two Parties.

- 5. The two Parties agree that in the event of research collaboration leading to patent rights, copyrights, or other intellectual property rights, a further agreement must be negotiated in each case in accordance with the policies of the two parties on intellectual property.
- 6. Amendment of this FCA is to be effected upon deliberation by the two Parties. No amendment, consent or waiver of terms of this FCA shall bind either party unless in writing and signed by both Parties.
- 7. This FCA shall be effective upon signature by the two Parties and shall remain in force for a period of five years. Thereafter it may be reviewed and extended upon agreement by the two Parties.
- 8. Termination of this FCA may be effected upon deliberation by the two Parties. Either Party has the right to terminate the memorandum without liability by giving six months' notice in writing of such intent.

9. This MoU is concluded in two copies with equal legal power in English; one copy to each Party.
