# ACADEMIC DISCIPLINE DESCRIPTION

**Objectives**: study of the history of Ukrainian statehood and the deep understanding of the history of formation of the Ukrainian people and Ukrainian state system, consolidation of the national originality, interpretation of the political activity of the classes and social group in Ukraine at the certain stages of the historical development.
