

PROFILE OF KEYNOTE SPEAKER



Tanner LeTourneau is a methodologist and senior teacher for the Edua language school in the Czech Republic.

He teaches and creates courses for both general and business English as well as English for sales.

Beyond that, Tanner has experience teaching English for academic purposes, Cambridge English test preparation,

English for refugees and immigrants, and English for young learners.

Professionally, Tanner has created and led specialized courses such as English for presentations, teleconferences, calling and emailing, etc. He oversees a team of 30 - 40 teachers and regularly provides feedback for their continual development and improvement.

He received his Master's degree in Linguistics at the University of Wisconsin - Milwaukee after completed his Bachelors degree in Spanish with a minor in Middle Eastern studies at the University of Wisconsin - Whitewater. His specialty is second language acquisition and online teaching. His research and study focused on interlanguage development as well as comparing language learning strategies of monolinguals learning a second language versus bilinguals learning a third language.

TEACHING LANGUAGES FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES AND WORKING IN AN INCREASINGLY ONLINE WORLD

Even before a global pandemic, online working and teaching has always been and increasingly prominent mode of operation for many. Today, pushed by global efforts to promote distance working, online teaching is now more of a reality than ever before. But has something been lost in that process? Have new challenges arisen? Is the online environment less or just as suitable for teaching language for specific purposes? How does this mode of teaching affect communication, connection, and the human experience in our classroom? In a world when online connection has a tendency to hurt or impede real connection, can real connection online instead be fostered for the betterment of language education and online learning success?

Language for any purpose is what makes us human and allows us to connect.

I will address these ideas, questions, and more as I draw from not only my own experiences from years of teaching online but also from being an active online learner of several languages and living and working in an increasingly digital world.
