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Комунікативні тести у читанні та тести лінгвістичної компетентності, а також ключі для самоперевірки – все це дозволяє виявити певні прогалини у володінні англійською мовою, оцінити рівень сформованості навичок у читанні, граматичних та лексичних навичок та опанувати технологію тестового контролю. Методичні рекомендації будуть корисними студентам, аспірантам та викладачам закладів вищої освіти.

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ПЕРЕДМОВА

Процеси демократизації, інтеграції, приєднання нашої держави до Європейського простору вищої освіти зумовлюють не лише зростання попиту на фахівців, які професійно володіють іноземною мовою, але й підвищення вимог до якості мовної підготовки і, в тому числі, до оцінювання рівня володіння іноземною мовою.

Дане видання пропонує зразки лінгводидактичних тестів загального володіння іноземною мовою. Джерелом відбору для тестових завдання послуговувались автентичні журнали, путівники, брошури, сучасні британські посібники та підручники.

Формат тесту передбачає дві частини – комунікативний тест у читанні та тест лінгвістичної компетентності (визнання рівня сформованості граматичних та лексичних навичок).

Завдання тесту у розділі «Читання» є перевірка рівня сформованості вмінь у таких видах читання:

- розуміння основного змісту;
- вилучення необхідної інформації;
- повне розуміння прочитанного.

Частина 1 (Читання) включає 35 завдань, з яких 10 – на встановлення співвідношення, 15 завдань з вибором правильної відповіді із чотирьох запропонованих, 10 завдань на трансформацію.

Завдання тесту у розділі «Лексика і граматика» є перевірка рівня сформованості навичок використовувати лексичний і граматичний матеріал у тестах комунікативної спрямованості.

Частина 2 (Лексико-граматична) – 26 завдань з вибором правильної відповіді із чотирьох запропонованих, 10 завдань на зіставлення, 2 завдання на групування.

Ключі до всіх тестів допоможуть під час самостійної роботи студентів.

Most schools in London are controlled by local authorities, although an increasing number of both primary and secondary schools are self-governing (grant-maintained). London has five City Technology Colleges to promote specialist training.

ELIZABETH II

Queen Elizabeth II is the 42nd ruler of England since William the Conqueror. Until she was 10 years old she did not expect to be Queen. Her full name is Elizabeth Alexandra Mary, but in family circle she has been called Lilibet. Elizabeth had a sheltered upbringing and never went to school. Instead she was taught by a governess and other tutors at Buckingham Palace and at Windsor, where she and her sister Princess Margaret lived during World War II. She continued to study history and constitutional law until she was 19.

From an early age her hobbies were riding and swimming. She was given a pony on her 4th birthday and won the Children's Challenge Shield for swimming when she was 13.

Just before the outbreak of war in 1939 Elizabeth had accompanied her parents on an engagement to the Royal Navy College where she met a young sailor who was a distant relation of hers. He was Prince Philip. Later he became her first and the only boyfriend. They married in Westminster Abbey when she was 21 and had four children: Prince Charles, Princess Anne, Prince Andrew, and Prince Edward.

When her father died suddenly in 1952, Elizabeth was well equipped to be Queen. She had been taught much about history of the United Kingdom and had travelled all over Britain attending official duties.

As Queen she undertakes more than 400 public engagements a year. In 1967 she introduced the "walkabout" so that she could meet more people. She has visited many countries at least once, and has more experience of state affairs than some prime ministers.

WHAT DO THE STARS EAT?

Film stars are everyone's favourite subject. People love to talk what they are wearing, who they are dating, and how much money they make. But have you ever wondered about what they eat?

Chefs and caterers (постачальники провізії) on film sets have the answers. "Every actor has different eating habits," says chef John Sharp. "Some stars love meat, eggs, or fish. Some stars love junk food, while others are constantly on a diet and eat only healthy food.

One thing for sure is that cooking for the stars is never easy, because they are often fussy eaters. "They want food fixed exactly the way they like and always have something to complain about," says caterer Susan Tate. Bill Murray won't eat watermelon with seeds in it, and Mickey Rourke insists on freshly squeezed carrot juice twice a day, but he won't drink it if it stands more than six minutes.

Cooking for stars is hard work, but few of these caterers ever think about changing jobs. "I love my work," says Susan Tate. "Where else can I see what Michelle Pfeiffer eats for breakfast or what Al Pacini has for a snack?"
